



Jian Zhou, Director of Media, and Wissam Trkmani, Project and Operations Manager. They arrived in Lahore on February 19, 2023, specifically to participate in the Fun Run. The OCA representatives were warmly received at the airport by a welcoming delegation from the Pakistan Olympic Association (POA), reflecting the spirit of international cooperation and camaraderie. The successful organization of the Fun Run not only added to the vibrancy of the 19th Asian Games festivities but also strengthened the ties between the POA and the OCA.

On February 19, 2023, the OCA delegation visited the headquarters of NOC Pakistan, where they were introduced to the Secretariat Staff. Mr. Muhammad Khalid Mahmood, Secretary General of the Pakistan Olympic Association, briefed Mr. Jian Zhou and Mr. Wissam Trkmani about the ongoing projects and initiatives of NOC Pakistan.





On February 27, 2023, the Asian Kabaddi Federation (AKF) conducted its Elective General Assembly in Urmi, Iran. This pivotal gathering was attended by Mr. Muhammad Khalid Mahmood, Secretary General of the Pakistan Olympic Association (POA), who participated in the capacity of an observer. His role as an observer was under the nomination of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA), highlighting the importance of the event in the context of Asian sports and the integral role of kabaddi within it. This assembly was a key moment for the AKF, setting the stage for its future direction and leadership.

CGF REGIONAL MEETING - OCEANIA / ASIA / AFRICA (March 1, 2023): The Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF) Regional Meeting, encompassing the regions of Oceania, Asia, and Africa, was held on March 1, 2023. Mr. Imran Ahmad Khan, Manager of Games Services at CGA Pakistan / NOC Pakistan, attended this significant meeting. The session provided an opportunity for sharing vital information among the Commonwealth Games Associations (CGAs) online. Key topics included updates from the CGF General Assembly, important details about the upcoming Trinbago 2023 Commonwealth Youth Games in Trinidad, and the latest information on athlete allocation for the Victoria 2026 Commonwealth Games.

OCA EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR TOP ATHLETES, POA HOUSE LAHORE (March 4, 2023): On March 4, 2023, an educational workshop for athletes was organized at Pakistan Olympic House, Lahore. This event, a collaboration between the Athletes Commission of the Pakistan Olympic Association and the Olympic Council of Asia, was aimed at empowering top athletes with essential knowledge and skills. The workshop saw the participation of 25 male and female athletes from diverse sports disciplines, including Archery, Badminton, Boxing, Gymnastics, Handball, Kabaddi, Rugby, Sailing, Weightlifting, Wrestling, Winter Sports, Wushu, and student athletes from LCWU Lahore. The sessions were led by distinguished experts: Dr. Meesaq Rizvi, an Olympian with IOC Certification in Sports Nutrition, spoke on sports nutrition; Maj (R) Dr. Lubna Sibtain, with IOC Certification as a Sports Physician, covered doping controls; Dr. Syed Asad Abbas Shah, a member of the OCA Medical Committee, discussed injury prevention in sports; Mr. Zia ud Din Khan Burki, a Ph.D. Scholar, delved into sports psychology; Mr. Muhammad Atif Shafiq, a Ph.D. Scholar and lecturer at GCU Lahore, addressed manipulation in sports; and Mr. Hamdan Nazir, a MEMOSIAN and President of the Pakistan Rowing Federation, spoke on awareness and protection against abuse and harassment in sports.

The ceremonial lighting of the Torch at Quaid-e-Azam Mazar in Karachi, on May 6, not only echoed the historical significance of the inaugural Games but also set in motion a journey of unity and sportsmanship across Pakistan. Traversing through key cities - Peshawar, Islamabad, Muzaffarabad AJK, and Lahore, the Torch's journey culminated in Quetta on May 14, symbolically ushering in the Games.

Hosted in Quetta, the heart of Balochistan, from May 22 to 30, the Games were a grand amalgamation of culture, sports, and national spirit, bringing together around 7000 participants. While the essence of the competitions echoed throughout Quetta, other regions like Karachi, Lahore, Islamabad, and Jhelum also played pivotal roles, hosting various sporting events.

The presence of distinguished guests such as the Honorable Prime Minister, Mian Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, and the Honourable President, Dr. Arif Alvi, at the opening and closing ceremonies respectively, added grandeur to the Games. This iteration of the National Games, especially significant after a hiatus of 19 years in Quetta, was not just a sporting event but a celebration of Pakistan's unity and the resilience of its sports community.

In a formidable showcase of athleticism and team spirit, the various units of Pakistan's sports fraternity competed with fervor and tenacity in the 34th National Games. The Army led the medal tally, showcasing their dominance with an impressive haul of 199 golds, contributing to their total of 398 medals. Not far behind, WAPDA demonstrated their prowess with 109 gold medals, while the Navy, exhibiting great skill and dedication, secured 28 golds. The Pakistan Air Force (PAF), Higher Education Commission (HEC), and the regional teams from Sindh to Gilgit Baltistan, all displayed commendable performances, contributing to the diverse medal spectrum.

The collective efforts of these teams and individual athletes culminated in a grand total of 1,256 medals, with 369 golds, 368 silvers, and 519 bronzes being awarded. A notable highlight was the exceptional achievement of Mr. Nooh Butt, who clinched the gold medal in Weightlifting +109 KG as an independent athlete under the flag of POA, a testament to the indomitable spirit and individual talent present in the games.

The 34th National Games not only celebrated the victories but also the unyielding spirit of sportsmanship and unity among competitors. Each medal won was a story of perseverance, each athlete's journey a narrative of inspiration, and together, they wove the fabric of a successful national sporting event that will be remembered for years to come.



















SEMINAR FOR ATHLETES AND OFFICIALS PARTICIPATING IN THE 19TH ASIAN GAMES HANGZHOU - 2-3 SEP 2023

Pakistan Olympic Association organized a two days Seminar for Athletes and Officials Participating in the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou on 2-3 Sep 2023 at Mayo Gardens, Pakistan Railways Lahore. The event brought together athletes, officials, and experts from the sports and medical fields to discuss essential topics geared towards optimizing athletic performance and ensuring the well-being of athletes. This seminar aimed to provide valuable insights and knowledge for participants ahead of the upcoming games.

The Seminar was attended by athletes and coaches (75 in person and 60 on zoom) who will participate in the 19th Asian Games in Hangzhou, China. Besides a large number of key personnel of the National Federations /sports organization along with their national athletes and coaches were also present.

IOC Certified experts on various medical fields, interacted with the athletes and officials set to leave for Hangzhou for the Asian Games. Dr. Lubna Sibtain, an IOC certified Sports Physician, made her presentation on the role of food in enhancing athletes' management performance and discussed the importance of making choices regarding supplements maintain health and performance integrity. Dr. Asad Abbas, IOC Certified in Sports Medicine and a Member of the Medical Committee of the Olympic Council of Asia, addressed the vital issue of "Doping Controls & ADEL Certification." Dr. Asad shared insights of the latest advancements in anti-doping measures and emphasized the importance of adhering to the highest standards of ethics and fair play in sports. Dr. Meesaq Rizvi, a distinguished medical professional with credentials of two time Olympian having IOC Sports Nutrition Diploma, provided invaluable insights into "Sports Nutrition." Dr. Meesaq shared expertise on tailoring nutrition plans to meet the unique demands of athletes, ensuring they achieve peak performance while staying healthy. The experts assured the athletes of their availability to attend the issues and guide coaches to best train athletes.



NOC Pakistan submitted over 700 accreditations for athletes and officials across 28 sports disciplines. Due to financial constraints, 4 national sports federations withdrew their entries. Pakistan's final participation included 135 male athletes (52%), 53 female athletes (20%), 64 male officials/coaches (24%), and 10 female officials/coaches (4%), totaling 262 members. The Delegation Registration Meeting for Pakistan, attended by a three-member delegation including Mr. Muhammad Khalid Mahmood, was held on September 16, 2023.









19th Asian Games Hangzhou, China (September - October 2023) Highlights:

Team Welcome Ceremony (Sept 22): Pakistan, along with five other countries, participated in the ceremony, exchanging souvenirs with the Village Mayor. Opening Ceremony (Sept 23): Inaugurated by President Xi Jinping of China, the ceremony featured over 12,000 athletes with Mr. Ghulam Mustafa Bashir and Ms. Nida Rashid as Pakistan's flag bearers.

Visits and Recognitions: Federal Secretary IPC & DG PSB visited the athletes; President POA awarded cash prizes for exceptional performances. Dope Tests: 15 athletes from 5 sports underwent doping tests. Closing Ceremony Flag Bearer: Mr. Muhammad Awais, a bronze medalist, represented Pakistan. Closing Ceremony Address (Oct 8): Given by Mr. Gao Zhidan, President of the Games Organising Committee and the Chinese Olympic Committee. Medal Achievements: Pakistan won medals in Squash (Silver), Shooting (Bronze), and Kabaddi (Bronze), with top 10 finishes in Athletics, Boxing, Karate, Weightlifting, and Volleyball. Strategic Meetings (Oct 2): Discussions with IOC and ISSF officials focused on mutual interests and collaboration. The journey of Asian Games started with the FUN RUN and ended with the culmination of the 19th Asian Games in an exceptional ceremony. The Games were nothing less than a marvel of the Modern Olympic Period.

In October 2023, the Pakistan Olympic Association (POA) was engaged in a series of significant activities and meetings. Mr. Muhammad Khalid Mahmood, Secretary General CGA Pakistan, participated in the online CGA Regional Meeting of the Commonwealth Games Federation on October 12. This was followed by the POA Finance Committee meeting on October 21 at the Pakistan Olympic House, chaired by Vice President POA Syed Muhammad Abid Qadri. The meeting focused on financial auditing and planning, with the President of POA also in attendance. On October 25, a celebratory ceremony was held for the Pakistan Wheelchair Cricket Team at the Pakistan Olympic House in Lahore, recognizing their victory in the 2nd Asia Cup 2023 in Kathmandu, Nepal. The following day, senior management course officers from various services, along with a faculty member from the National Institute of Management Lahore, visited the Olympic House to discuss sports-related public service issues. The month's activities concluded with an Executive Committee Meeting of NOC Pakistan on October 27, presided over by Lt Gen (R) Syed Arif Hasan. This meeting, held in both virtual and physical formats, covered a range of important topics including international games, financial matters, and the Olympic Movement in Pakistan.





















In November 2023, Pakistan Olympic Association (POA) in collaboration with the Athletes Commission of POA organized an interactive session with athletes initiating a new format Meet and Educate Athletes. The Athletes who secured Gold Medals in the National Games Quetta were invited to attend the seminar and ask questions from the officials of the National Sports Federations and qualified personnel to address on key areas related to the Doping Controls, Competition Manipulation, their rights regarding Non-Accidental Violence, training sessions and competition schedules. The athletes amazed all by their questions and desire to know more about all areas concerning their professional growth.

A dinner was hosted to acknowledge the valuable partnership with DHA Lahore in last few years including organization of various National Championships of various sports as well as the conduct of the events like Olympic Day, FUN RUN for Asian Games. DHA Lahore has extended valuable support for athlete development. The event was hosted by Lt. Gen (R) Syed Arif Hasan and Brig. Gul Wahid Satti former Administrator DHA Lahore and Brig. Yasir Mirza, the current Administrator DHA Lahore graced the occasion with their presence.

Lt. Gen (R) Syed Arif Hasan, President POA attended the Saudi Games and General Assembly of ISSF in Riyadh. During the visit, Mr. Muhammad Khalid Mahmood, Secretary General POA also visited the Saudi Olympic Academy and discussed the opportunities of collaboration.

Besides these highlighted events, there were numerous other assignments and activities undertaken during this period that are not detailed in this report. The POA Secretariat, under the guidance and leadership of Lt. Gen (R) Syed Arif Hasan, President POA, diligently performs various critical functions behind the scenes, essential for the organization's effective functioning and achievement of its goals.
