**Dear Friends and Colleagues,**

Please accept the best greetings of the OCA and I would like to inform you that the OCA has held prolonged discussions with the NOC of Thailand and the Sports Authority of Thailand with regard to hosting of the 6<sup>th</sup> Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games in Thailand in February/March 2024.

It was felt that the NOCs are now preparing themselves for the Olympic Games in Paris and it will be difficult for the NOCs to allocate budget for the 6<sup>th</sup> AIMAG. Moreover, most of the athletes are already in training camps for the Olympic Games, and it will be difficult for them to participate in the 6<sup>th</sup> AIMAG.

It was therefore mutually agreed that the 6<sup>th</sup> Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games should be **rescheduled** to be held after the Paris Olympic Games. This will also provide time to the Organizing Committee to better prepare for the games. The exact dates will be finalized by the OCA Executive Board looking at the international sports calendar.

We look forward to your understanding and cooperation.
