Subject: Application for Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUES)

Dear NOC Friends and Colleagues,

Warm greetings from HAGOC!

Please receive our sincere greetings from the Anti-Doping Department of the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 Organising Committee!

With the guidance and support from OCA, the preparation of Asian Games 2022 Anti-doping Program has been effective, and we would like to provide information on the application for **Therapeutic Use Exemptions**.

Athletes may have illnesses or conditions that require them to take medications or undergo procedures. If the medication or method an athlete is required to use to treat an illness or condition is prohibited as per **WADA's Prohibited List**, a TUE will give that athlete the authorization to use that substance or method while competing without invoking an anti-doping rule violation (ADRV) and applicable sanction.

Following the OCA's review and approval, the "Application Process for Therapeutic Use Exemptions for the Asian Games 2022" is now available to all NOCs on the official website of ITA as follows:
