- 1. IOC Diploma in Sports Physical Therapies is a Distance Learning, part-time basis, running for a period of six months from October of each year, and takes two years to complete. The aims and outcomes of this program is to provide students with detailed knowledge of the scientific underpinning of the practice of sports physical therapies, to promote understanding of current best practice in sports physical therapies, to make students aware of the practical issues involved in the practice of sports physical therapies ,to train students in research methods relevant to the study of sports physical therapy ,to develop skills in written communication of original scientific material
- 2.  - International GCSE English as a Second Language Grade C or above
 - International Baccalaureate (IB) Grade 4 minimum in English
 - CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) B2 (Upper Intermediate) or above
